- Clause 1: In accordance with the "YZU Student Award Details" (hereinafter referred to as the Award Details), the recommendation conditions for activities, services, and talent awards are clearly defined, and these review rules are specially formulated.
- Clause 2: The medals are classified into Achievement Medals, Gold Medals, and Silver Medals.
- Clause 3: The eligibility criteria for medal applications are as follows:
 - 1. The eligibility criteria for Achievement Medals are limited to graduating students of the academic year and must comply with the provisions of Clause 7 of the Award Details.
 - 2. The eligibility criteria for the Gold Medal must comply with the provisions of Clause 6 of the Award Regulations. If the Extracurricular Affairs Section of the Student Affairs Office (hereinafter referred to as the Extracurricular Section) determines that they do not qualify based on the preliminary review of the Award Regulations, they may switch their recommendation application to the Silver Medal of the same category.

3. Silver Award

- a. Club/organization staff members who wish to apply for the Silver Activity Award must comply with paragraph 3 of Clause 5 of the Award Details. The recommendation quota standards are as follows:
 - i. Academic & literary arts, social, musical, recreational and sports clubs that are awarded "Excellent" based on the school's club evaluation results can be granted 4 recommendation slots, and A-Level clubs can be granted 2 recommendation slots.
 - ii. Each Club that wins the "First Rank" in the national evaluation according to its club nature can be granted two additional recommendation slots, and the "Second Rank" can be granted one additional recommendation slots. (無修正)

- b. Staff members applying for the Silver Service Award must adhere to Clause 5, Paragraph 4 of the Award Details. The recommended quota standards are as follows:
 - i. Autonomous clubs rated "Qualified" in the school's evaluation receive 2 recommendation slots.
 - ii. Volunteer clubs rated "Qualified" in the school's evaluation receive 3 recommendation slots.
 - iii. Service clubs awarded "Excellent" in the school's evaluation receive 4 recommendation slots (A-level clubs receive 2 slots, and B-level clubs receive 1 slot).
 - iv. Each club that achieves the "First Rank" in the national evaluation will be granted 2 additional recommendation slots, and the "Second Rank" will be granted 1 additional recommendation slot.
- c. The qualifications to apply for the Talent Silver Award are based on the first place in the school-wide competition and the top three ranks and honors in off-campus talent competitions.
 - i. "School-wide competition" refers to a talent competition in which all students in the school are eligible to participate, and the registered teams must be cross-college and exceed 10 teams; "off-campus talent competition" refers to more than 4 participating universities and more than 10 participating teams.
 - ii. A special honor refers to the competition details compiled by the Extracurricular Activity Section under the Office of Student Affairs. Other details include the total participants, awarded lists and contest levels. When all the details are ratified by the preliminary meeting and sent to the Student Activity Committee for further review.
 - iii. As to the talent competitions with the participation of groups and teams, if there are too many team members to give individuals a chance to show his/her talent, the team members are not qualified for talent medals.
- d. If individuals wish to apply for the Activity, Service, and Talent Silver Medals, they can submit records indicating their participation in announced activities. These activities should be listed in the five-category list, and their outstanding performance should align with the principle of bringing honor to the university.
- 4. Those who have not met the qualifications listed in this clause but their special performance or achievement is enough for the application of Activity, Service and Talent Medals, they can submit the related records and the explanation why they should be awarded. Their applications should be submitted to the Extracurricular Activity Group

within the deadline. Once they pass the preliminary review, their applications will be handled according to the Medal Review Procedures listed in this set of Review Details.

- Clause 4: Those who have met the application qualifications may submit their related records to the Extracurricular Activities Section. Once they have passed the preliminary reviews conducted by the Extracurricular Activities Section and a second review by the Student Activities Committee, the name list will be handed over to the Student Affair meeting by the Office of Student Affairs as recommendations. Then the name list will be ratified by the Student Affair meeting before public announcement
- Clause 5: The application time and schedule are based on the announcement publicized by the Extracurricular Activity Group. The medal applicants should keep a good record of related documents and proofs that can be used for the applications of medals.
- Clause 6: Matters not covered in these detailed rules shall be handled in accordance with the provisions of the school's student Award Details.
- Clause 7: This set of details is ratified in the Student Affair meeting before implementation. All amendments require the same procedures.

If any controversies or disputes occurred regarding the clauses of the regulations, it shall always refer to the Chinese version.
